

1. **Red restarts play with** a 20 metre optional kick. Red kicks the ball backwards over the dead ball line on the full.
2. The full time siren sounds. The Red fullback kicks the ball to the Blue fullback who throws the ball forward into touch.
3. The full time siren sounds. The Red fullback kicks the ball to the Blue fullback who kicks the ball forward into touch on the full.
4. Is it compulsory for a team to take a kick at goal after a try has been scored.
5. After the last play the ball, Red kicks and the ball accidentally hits another offside Red player. Blue attempts to regather the ball but knocks on.
6. Red knocks on in the field of play. The ball rolls into the Blue in-goal where Blue regathers and passes to another Blue player also in-goal who knocks on. Blue kicks the ball over the Blue dead ball line.
7. A player holds back an opposition player attempting to score a try. The referee awards a penalty try. Can the referee sin bin the offending player?
8. Red punt kicks the ball directly from a free kick. Blue catches the ball on the full with one foot on the Blue goal line and one foot in the field of play. Blue then forces the ball in the Blue in-goal
9. Red drop kicks a differential penalty which goes over the Blue cross bar. A Blue player catches the ball on the full and then stands on the Blue dead ball line.
10. Red knocks on in the field of play. The Red player regathers the ball and in frustration kicks the ball over the Blue dead ball line.
